

## Pupil Premium /EAL report To Governing Body - Belmont Castle Academy - 2019

### Pupil Premium (PP)

- ✿ 20% of population are Pupil Premium
- ✿ PP data has been analysed on a termly basis to ensure suitable deployment of staff. PP Lead works with Year Leads and discusses effectiveness of interventions and deployment of team. 50 PP children supported in class for Maths & Literacy, Phonics groups, individual reading or through intervention groups.
- ✿ 50 % of PP children have attended the Wizards Workshop after school. As soon as PP children join BCA an invite is sent to Parents/ Carers to invite children to attend the after school club. Children complete Reading, comprehension spelling and Maths programs. Specific children are targeted with reading their books. Circle time is carried out at each session. Certificates and rewards are given to children who achieve milestones. Wizard Workshop attendees made Christmas decorations to sell at the Christmas Fayre
- ✿ TAs' Performance Management has been completed. All TA's performance was judged as good or better.
- ✿ New Learning mentor has completed PP training.
- ✿ 2 PP children have been support with payment of swimming fees
- ✿ 2 PP children have had dinner arrears cleared
- ✿ 3 PP children have singing lessons paid for
- ✿ 1 PP child has Chelsea Girls football academy fees paid for
- ✿ 3 bereaved children attend Wizards every day and breakfast club is paid for each day
- ✿ CAF completed and daily support given to 3 bereaved children
- ✿ 2 More Able groups are run weekly for PP children.
- ✿ Writing, GPS & comprehension are the focus for PP children this term
- ✿ Less children are reading at lunchtime due to supporting lunchtime cover. This is reflected negatively on the data
- ✿ Wizards Easter holiday club will run and a magician has been booked for children. Children will make their own pizza/ picnic lunch together with the usual holiday activities we arrange
- ✿ Speech & Language TA now supports x2 Year 1 groups, x5 Reception groups and x2 Nursery groups weekly. The focus is on Speech link activities, Book focus (pre teaching) and story sack and language focused play.
- ✿ Barriers to learning & more able questionnaires are completed and children are signposted accordingly

### EAL & Diversity

- ✿ Ethnicity & language analysis completed and charts developed to show our population make up. Classes display figures for all to see. EAL 47%, 37 different languages.
- ✿ New to Language learners are supported with Phonics, GPS, reading and comprehension. Children in KS1 attend Speech Link groups (5 children currently being supported)
- ✿ 2 EAL TA's deployed to support new to language and EAL children struggling with reading & phonics. Talk groups are held, Reading Eggs support and GPS interventions are carried out (35 children receiving in class & intervention support)
- ✿ 7 EAL mentors have been appointed to support EAL children with language issues and on the playground.
- ✿ 13/16 of Pupil Parliament representatives are EAL or ethnicity is not White British
- ✿ Sri Lankan dancing club is run by EAL team & a Parent. Sri Lankan dancing club performed at the Gold Diversity award assembly.
- ✿ Culture & heritage display board created and a Black History display board completed
- ✿ All classes display a global Learning community map in their classes with pupil profiles attached.
- ✿ Black History month assembly included a cultural fashion presentation by children with one Parent presenting too.
- ✿ The Gold Diversity award assembly included a cultural fashion show and Bollywood dancing

- ✳ School attended the Torn from Home – holocaust memorial event at the Thameside Theatre.
- ✳ European Language day was celebrated in September 2018.
- ✳ AB to support PG with Valencia trip and sending emails to the Spanish Schools we will visit.

### Pupil Parliament

- ✳ New BCA Pupil Parliament created through self-nomination, presentations and a subsequent ballot
- ✳ Pupil Parliament members attend monthly meetings
- ✳ Pupil Parliament members went to the food bank following Harvest Festival donations
- ✳ Pupil Parliament members attended Remembrance Sunday Service in Grays town centre
- ✳ Pupil Parliament members held a mock Parliamentary debate in assembly with a speaker. Following this an open surgery was held for Y5&6 children. The Mayor of Thurrock and MP John Kent attended.
- ✳ Pupil Parliament members assigned responsibilities as follows PE & Sport, Environment & the Playground, The love of Reading & Writing, Extra-curricular activities & Diversity, Homework & How we learn best, Problem solving & maths, ICT & Science and Behaviour, Bullying & Welfare.
- ✳ During Parliament week commencing 21<sup>st</sup> January we held open surgeries for Y2-Y6 in order for children to put forward their suggestions on how to improve the school. Children were encouraged to use their Pupil Voice. A summary of points raised will be present by the BCA PP to the SLT in due course.
- ✳ Houses of Parliament visit arranged for 13<sup>th</sup> February with BCA Pupil Parliament members (MJ & AB)

- ✳ AB set up 2 counselling rooms and has 3 clients for the BCA Listening Service
- ✳ Running training for KS1 Indoor Athletics competition (AB)
- ✳ Cross Country competition for KS2 won by BCA (DGS)
- ✳ Boys & Girls football club & league games (DGS)
- ✳ Cricket (DGS)
- ✳ Tag Rugby (DGS)
- ✳ Hi 5 (NP)
- ✳ DGS covering KS1 PPA
- ✳ DGS attending football coaching FA course, Outstanding PE and Primary Games courses
