The EYSEND Partnership is working across England to improve access and inclusion in the early years by providing a programme of support on SEN and disability to a wide range of early years settings, local authority staff, health professionals and parent/carers.

Co-production and family partnership working is central to developing high quality provision for children with SEND.

This learning event will be delivered over two sessions and led by Gail Bedding, Contact EYs SEND Project Manager & Catherine Ratcliffe, Contact Associate. It will provide opportunities for you to learn more about co-production and family partnership working, to reflect upon what is going well and to identify areas of development to continue to improve your practice and wider practice across the borough.

There will be a particular focus upon early years and how family partnership working can support transition into school and continue in the primary phase.

## Who should attend this learning event?

The learning event should be attended by Early Years SENCOs and Managers (including pre-schools, nurseries and childminders) and Primary SENCOs as well as all other professionals from health, education and care services working with early years and primary school children with SEND and their families.
